NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 551.041 of the Texas Government Code, that the Navigation and Canal Commissioners of the Victoria County Navigation District (the "District") will meet on May 21, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. at the District's administrative office, located at 1934 FM 1432, Victoria, Texas.

 - ii) To receive, review, and consider ratification of an Engagement Letter between the District and the Baker Botts law firm for the provision of legal services, and take appropriate action.
- B. Operations Manager Activities and matters related to waterborne traffic activity; security matters; and operations at the Port of Victoria.
- C. <u>Finance Committee</u> Activities and matters related to financial status and results; investments; insurance; financial management issues; project financing; budgeting and tax rate analysis; and financial audit process.
- D. <u>Facilities Committee</u> Activities and matters related to the Channel to Victoria; capital and other projects; infrastructure, maintenance issues, infrastructure planning and development; transportation issues; safety and security measures; and other related engineering or environmental matters.
 - To receive and review bid tabulations and related information pertaining to bids received in the re-bid process for the construction of the Port of Victoria South Industrial Site Rail Build-Out Project, consider recommendations from Staff regarding same, including the potential acceptance or rejection of specific bids and awarding of an appropriate
